RESOLUTION
SETTING WATER PRICES FOR WCBWDS
INTERRUPTIBLE WATER SUPPLY AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, following its acquisition from the Brazos River Authority (“**BRA**”) of the West Central Brazos Water Distribution System (“**WCBWDS**”), the District entered into an Interruptible Water Supply Agreement (“**IWAA**”) with one or more District water supply customers along the WCBWDS (“**WCBWDS Customers**”), for re-sale by the District of raw water from Possum Kingdom Reservoir (“**PK Water**”) purchased by the District from BRA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to each IWAA, the Purchaser therein is obligated to pay for the right to purchase and receive (if and when available) the Contract Amount of PK Water stated in its IWAA, at a Price equal to the product of multiplying the Price per acre-foot set by the District’s Board of Directors by the Contract Amount stated in the Customer’s IWAA, regardless of whether the full Contract Amount is diverted and used by the Purchaser, and subject to annual adjustment (increase) of the Price by the Board of Directors effective as of January 1 of each Contract Year, which Price the Board of Directors of the District has determined to adjust and increase as of January 1, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the West Central Texas Municipal Water District, that, effective for the period January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020, the Price payable under each existing and new IWAA with the District shall be (1) \$55.80 per acre-foot times the Contract Amount stated in such IWAA for each Customer purchasing and using PK Water solely for agricultural purposes and (2) \$79.50 per acre-foot times the Contract Amount for each Customer purchasing and using PK Water solely for other non-municipal (e.g., mining, industrial, etc.) purposes.
